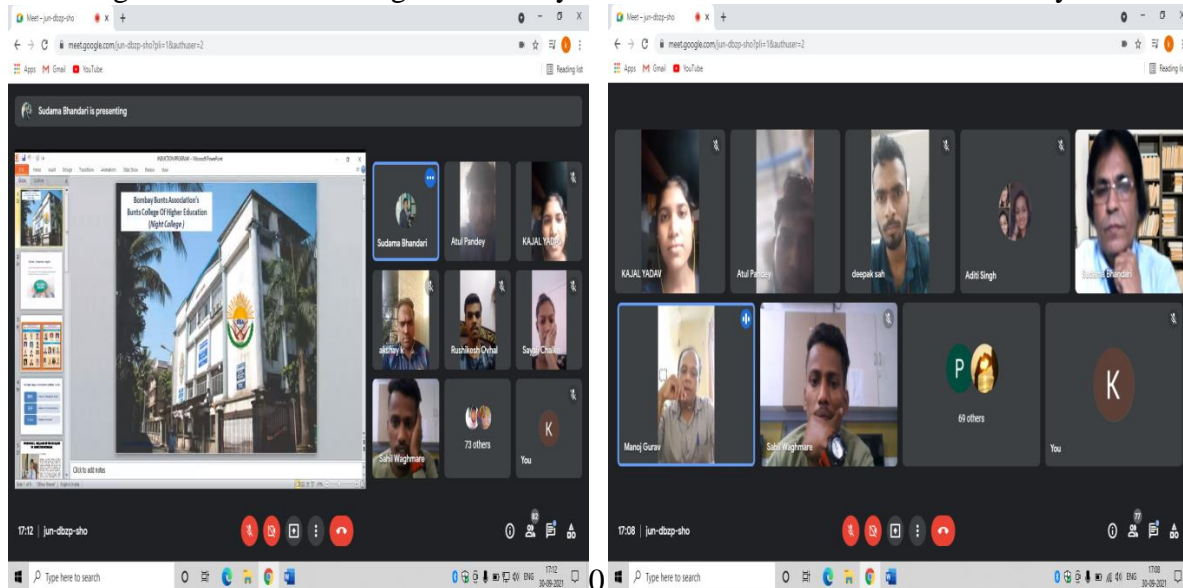




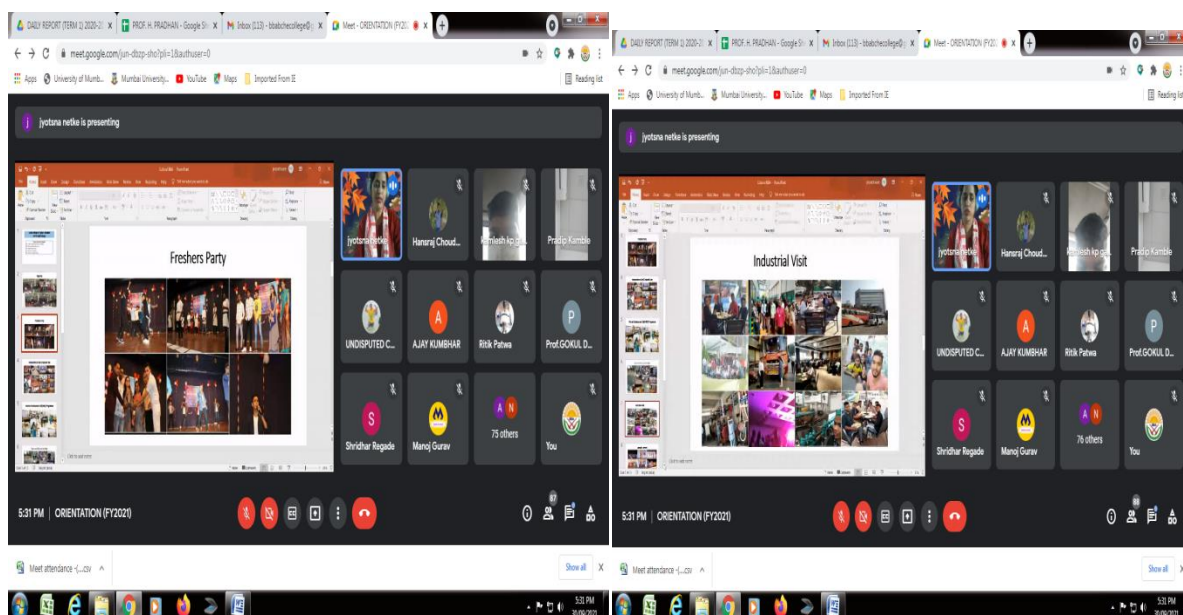
BUNTS COLLEGE OF HIGHER EDUCATION (NIGHT COLLEGE)

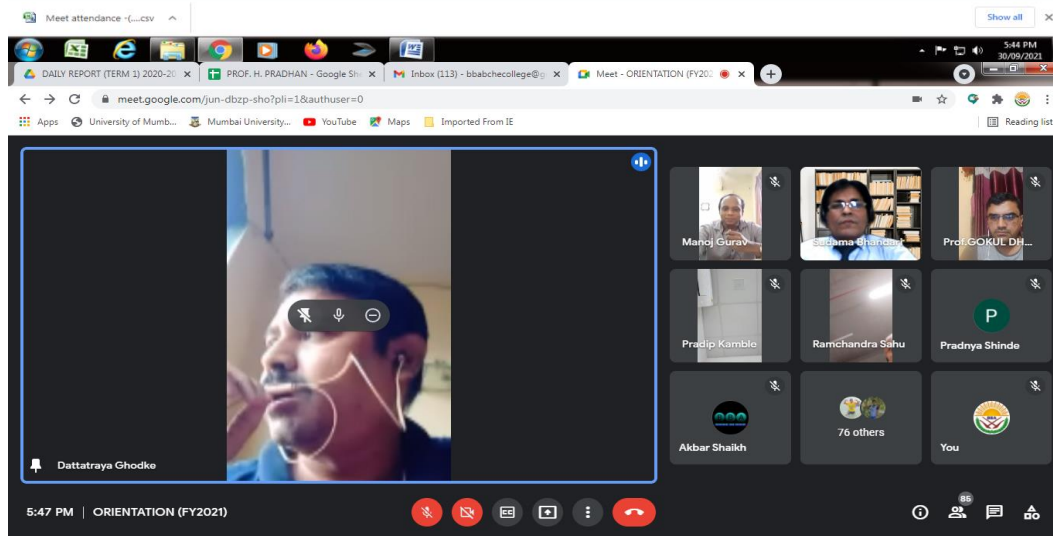
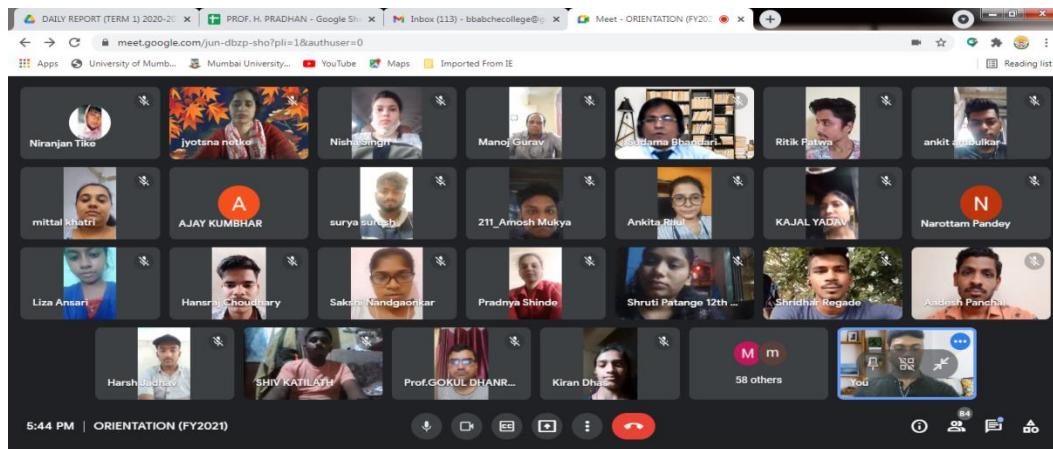


The principal provided information and opportunities to explore academic success strategies with the help of power point presentation. He stressed on physical environment of the campus and the integrated social support system and connection with other students.
