The lecture started by 2.30 p. m. The speaker covered all the aspects of teaching day to day and practical life. He began the session by expressing admiration the Excellence in Teaching & Learning. His message was those who do not love teaching should not teach. The teacher must keep and equip themselves with modern teaching gadgets. Teachers suppose to be well versed, and good communication with sound personality. The image of the teacher is always respected in the society. So there is need to create such environment where teaching – learning process goes as per the society and system. Teachers should stay abreast of new developments in education by reading good books and journals. Teachers need to improve our stock of words and cultivate reading habits, explore new words and never take a break language.



During the session he also placed 4 kinds of people with different classification of teachers like Super keepers, Keepers, Solid Citizens and Misfits. The teacher's personalities based on 3-H Philosophy like Head, Heart, and Hands.

For the justification of teaching enrichment, he quoted David Kolbe's Learning Cycle which is called CLD (Continuous Learning & Development). This process displayed that how to deal with the students in different situation. Sometime students have better questions or answers to the teachers. So there is need to improve the strength of teaching and to avoid mistakes. We must believe that every student is our experiment. They may be role models in our learning teaching process.

To encourage and motivational purpose teachers the speaker quoted, "Take care of the process & the process will take care of the results. He has turned out to be successful in life in spite of all the hurdles they faced." He further advised teachers to avoid arrogance, complacency and develop the culture of excellence. Never involve in gossiping and don't speak ill about the institution.



Learning is essential and relatively permanent change in the attitude and behavior of a teacher therefore there is need of educational training time to time. Further he also suggested that the educational outcome v/s educational output, employee must know the following line – “To teach mathematics to Peter, you need to know not only mathematics but also Peter...” He concluded by saying that we should develop the vibrant learning ability with a sense of Purpose, Pride, Direction and Commitment.

Sir, also conducted question hours. Many teachers asked question at the end of the session. The faculties were very happy. The programme was most interesting, boosting morale, loaded with thoughts, enriched learning experience as our dynamic management itself joined the entire program.
